Laynha is a well-established and reputable Indigenous organisation servicing the Yolngu residents in 30 Homelands across the North East Arnhem Land.

We have been funded until 30 November 2022 to provide a Family Violence Service to people in Yirrkala, Nhulunbuy and surrounding areas. You will lead a team of two Yolngu Outreach Workers to deliver a service that is part of the *National Plan to Reduce Violence against Women and their Children*. This will be achieved by improving and expanding culturally age-appropriate services for Indigenous women and children who have been affected by family and domestic violence.

What will you need to succeed? You will hold relevant qualifications in counselling, social work, psychology (or related field). You understand and have used in clinical settings the principles of Trauma Informed Care with children and young people. You understand and have used appropriate diagnostic tools and therapies (e.g. Play Therapy). You understand and can comply with the National Risk Assessment Principles and the National Outcome Standards for Perpetrator Interventions.

You will have (a) a current Police Check and Working with Children and Vulnerable People clearance; (b) a manual driver's licence; (c) current registration and/or accreditation with a relevant professional body (e.g. ACA).

What kind of person are you? You will have strong personal values, a high level of personal integrity and a commitment to ethical behaviour. You communicate effectively with Indigenous people. You are confident, calm, self-resilient, independent thinking with a robust sense of humour and a willingness to learn.

Benefits include 6 weeks' annual leave with 17.5% leave loading, annual travel assistance allowance and a commitment to professional development. **You are also able to access salary sacrifice arrangements, including increased tax-free benefit of up to \$17,000 and tax-free holiday accommodation and meals.**
